

ORDINANCE NO. 2020.10-21

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CERTAIN PROVISIONS OF CHAPTER 112 OF MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE VILLAGE OF SALEM LAKES RELATING TO PLAN COMMISSION ORGANIZATION AND RESPONSIBILITIES.

The Village Board of the Village of Salem Lakes, Kenosha County, Wisconsin, does hereby ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. Purpose. The purpose of this ordinance is to amend certain provisions of the Municipal Code relating to the organization and responsibilities of the Village's Plan Commission.

SECTION 2. Section 112-3 Amended. Section 112-3 of the Salem Lakes Municipal Code is amended to provide as follows:

§ 112-3 Officers. The Village President shall appoint a Chair. The Commission shall elect a Vice-Chair and appoint a Secretary for the Commission.

SECTION 3. Section 112-9 Amended. Section 112-9 of the Salem Lakes Municipal Code is amended to provide as follows:

§ 112-9 Quorum. Four members shall constitute a quorum. All actions shall require approval of a majority of the Commissioners voting at any meeting at which a quorum is present.

SECTION 4. Section 112-11 Amended. Section 112-11 F of the Salem Lakes Municipal Code is hereby deleted and Section 112-11 E is amended to provide as follows:

E. To prepare and make recommendations to the Village Board regarding applications for conditional use permits in accordance with the general and specific rules set out in the Village Zoning Ordinance.

SECTION 5. Severability. Each section, subsection, paragraph, sentence, clause, phrase and provision of the foregoing ordinance is and the same is hereby declared to be severable and if any portion or provision thereof is duly determined to be invalid for any reason, such determination shall not invalidate any other portion or provision thereof.

SECTION 6. Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect and be enforced from and after publication and posting as required by law.
