

ORDINANCE NO. 2022.10-58

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTIONS 490-26.2 and 490-26.3 OF THE SALEM LAKES MUNICIPAL CODE DESIGNATING TATTOO AND BODY-PIERCING ESTABLISHMENTS AS PRINCIPAL USES IN B-2 AND B-3 ZONING DISTRICTS.

The Village Board of the Village of Salem Lakes, Kenosha County, Wisconsin, does hereby ordain as follows:

SECTION 1. Purpose. The purpose of this ordinance is to amend sections 490-26.2 and 490-26.3 of the Salem Lakes Municipal Code to designate tattoo and body-piercing establishments as principal, rather than conditional, uses in B-2 and B-3 zoning districts.

SECTION 2. Section 490-26.2 B. (45) Created. Section 490-26.2 B. (45) of the Salem Lakes Municipal Code relating to principal uses in the B-2 zoning district is created to provide as follows:

(45) Tattoo and body piercing establishments.

SECTION 3. Section 490-26.2 D. (13) Deleted. Section 490-26.2 D. (13) of the Salem Lakes Municipal Code designating tattoo and body piercing establishments as conditional uses in the B-2 zoning district is deleted.

SECTION 4. Section 490-26.3 B. (6) Created. Section 490-26.3 B. (6) of the Salem Lakes Municipal Code relating to principal uses in the B-3 zoning district is created to provide as follows:

(6) Tattoo and body piercing establishments.

SECTION 5. Section 490-26.3 D. (20) Deleted. Section 490-26.3 D. (20) of the Salem Lakes Municipal Code designating tattoo and body piercing establishments as conditional uses in the B-3 zoning district is deleted.

SECTION 6. Severability. Each section, subsection, paragraph, sentence, clause, phrase and provision of the foregoing ordinance is and the same is hereby declared to be severable and if any portion or provision thereof is duly determined to be invalid for any reason, such determination shall not invalidate any other portion or provision thereof.

SECTION 7. Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect and be enforced from and after publication and posting as required by law.
